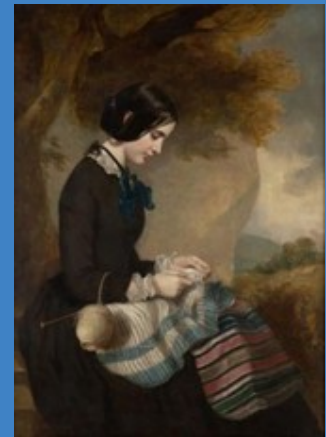



If you are unable to leave home without assistance or significant effort we can bring the library to you. Just submit [this form](#). Homebound delivery is only available to those who live in the 99019 and 99016 zip codes.



Homebound delivery is made on the fourth Wednesday of every month. A Library staff member will visit your residence with up to 5 print books, 2 DVDs, and 2 books on CD for you to borrow for 1 month. You may choose the number of items you would like to have delivered within those limits. The staff member will pick up the items you had borrowed and return them to the Library. Homebound delivery patrons do not accrue late charges.

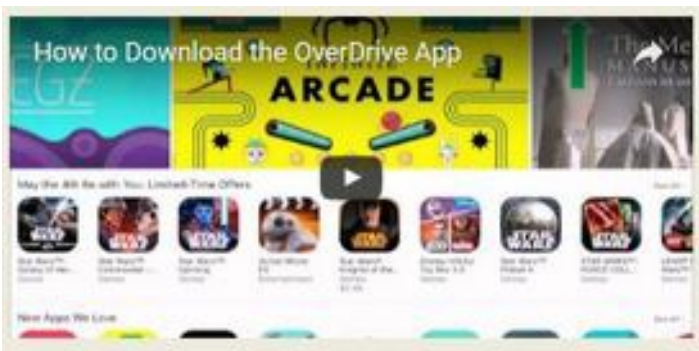

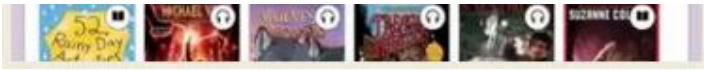
